Per the Rules, each unit will be allowed one OFC registration sticker for each of two (2) motor vehicles. Motorcycles and scooters must also be registered and are included in the two (2) allowed vehicles. Any additional vehicle will require the approval of the Executive Board and will be subject to such reasonable conditions as the Executive Board or Management may impose in regard to the parking site for such additional vehicle.

I am the owner of the vehicle(s) and agree to the following:

1. I will affix each parking sticker indicated above to the left rear bumper or to the front of the rear-view mirror of the vehicle to which it applied.
2. I will return each parking sticker as and if the vehicle to which it applies is disposed of and/or when my residency terminates.
3. I will report the acquisition of other vehicles by making new parking permit applications for them.
4. I will not hold the Old Forge Crossing Association responsible for theft or damage to my vehicle(s) or to my possessions therein.
5. It is understood that all vehicles within Old Forge Crossing that have expired registration and/or inspection tags or appear to be abandoned will be towed away at owner's expense after written notice has been given.
6. All commercial vehicles must park in an area designated by Management.
7. Residential parking spaces are not to be used as storage spaces for vehicles not in regular use. No vehicle is to be left parked in any one space for more than thirty (30) days. Owners of permanently parked vehicles will be asked to move them; failure to do so may result in a lienable fine.
8. I will review the full Rules and Regulations pertaining to Vehicles and Parking.
